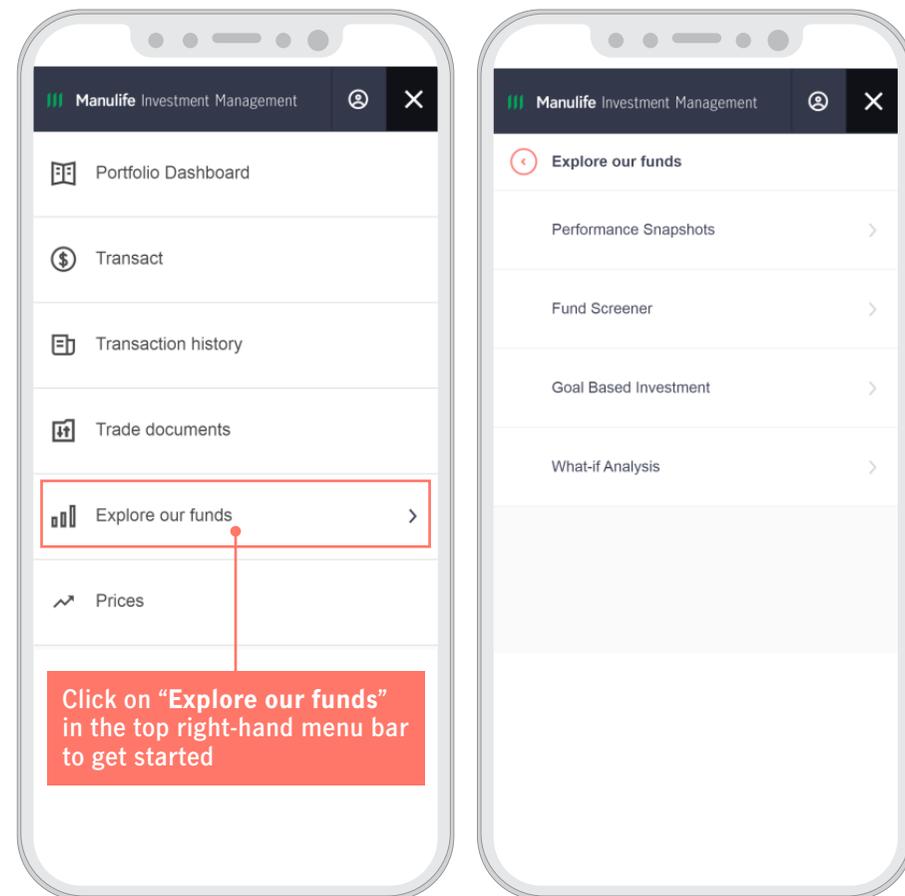

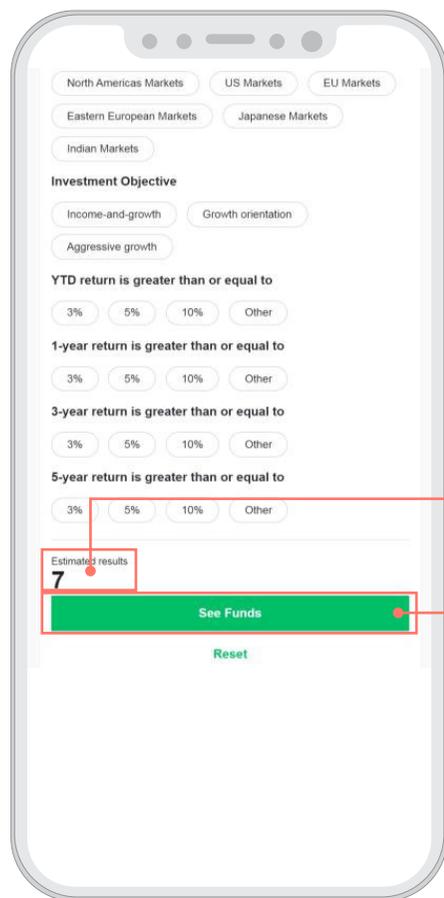
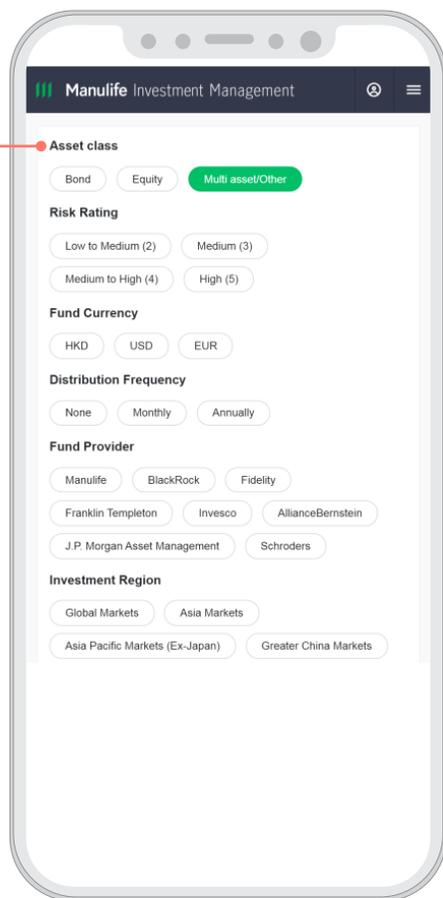

# Fund Screener

1 Select certain criteria such as asset class, risk rating, returns and more



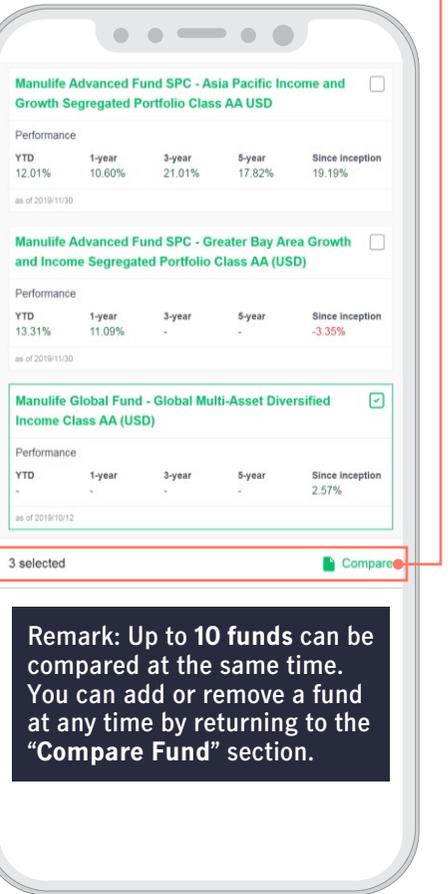
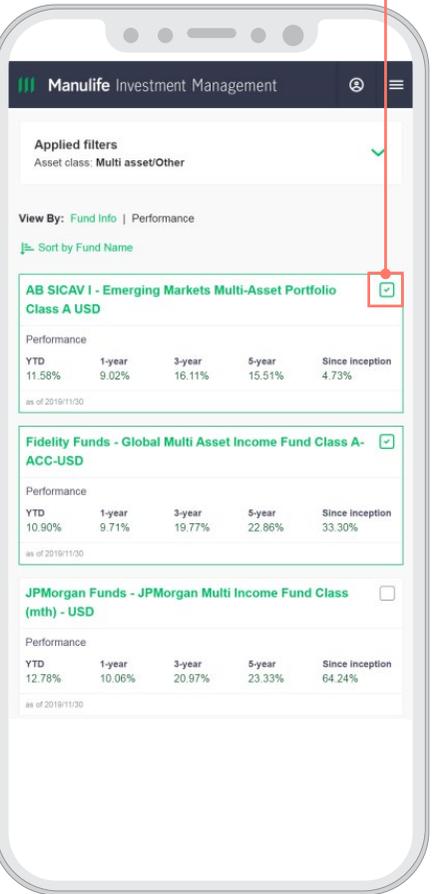
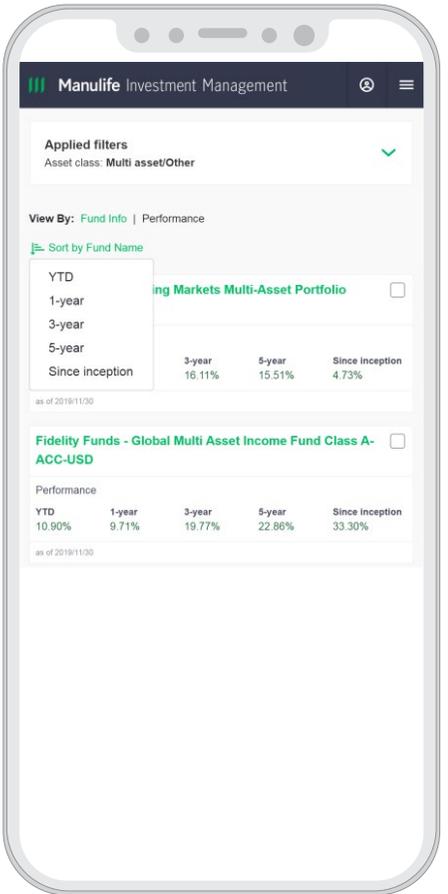
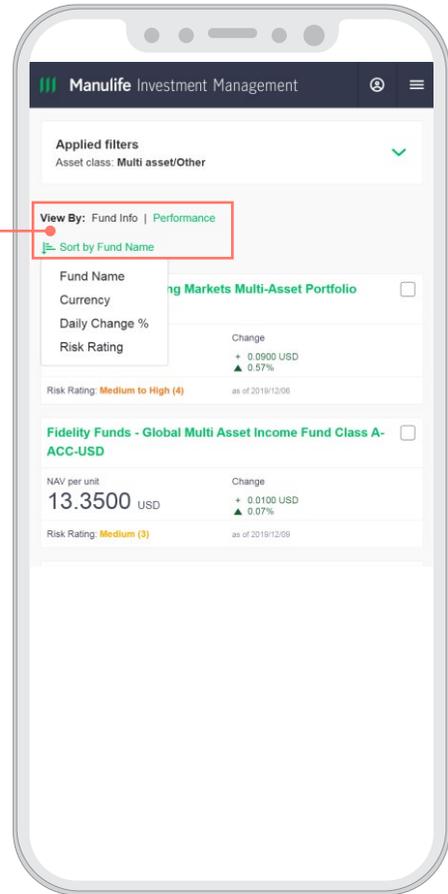
2 See how many funds match your search under "Estimated results"

**4** View the results by “Fund info” or “Performance”, and also sort them into a different order by clicking on the header “Sort by” at the top

**5** Tick the box next to the fund name to compare fund performance

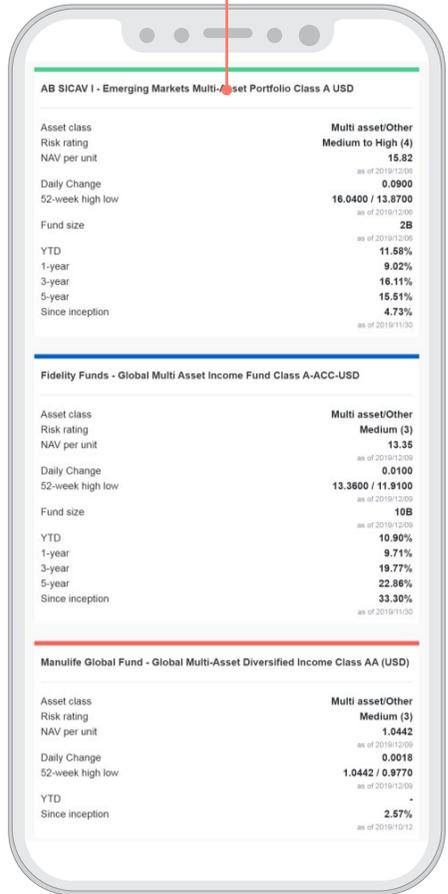
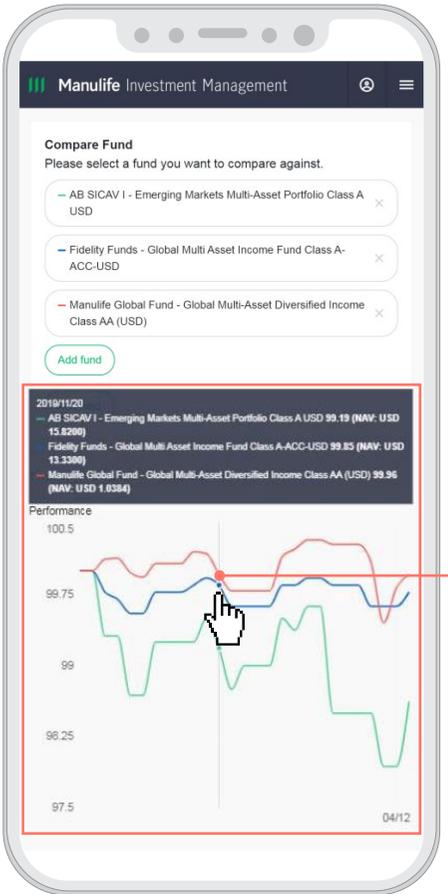
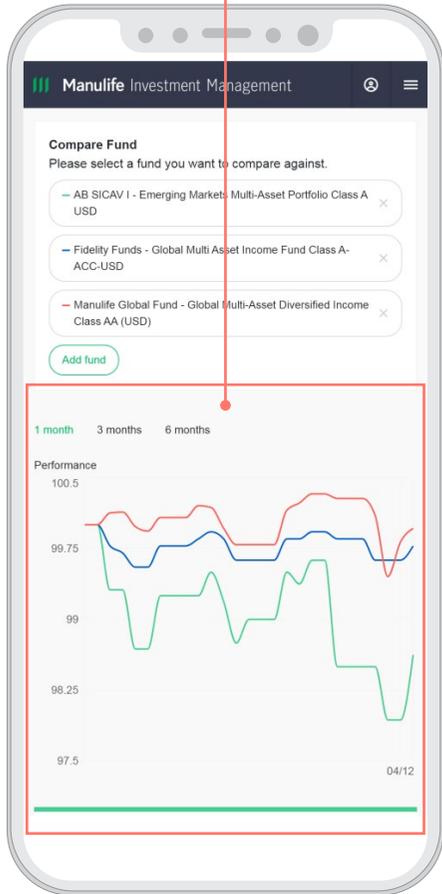
**6** See the number of funds selected at the bottom. Click on “Compare” to proceed



**7** See the fund performance comparison results by selecting the timeframe (1 month, 3 months or 6 months) at the top of the graph

**8** Place your mouse over any point on the graph to see the details of the fund at that time

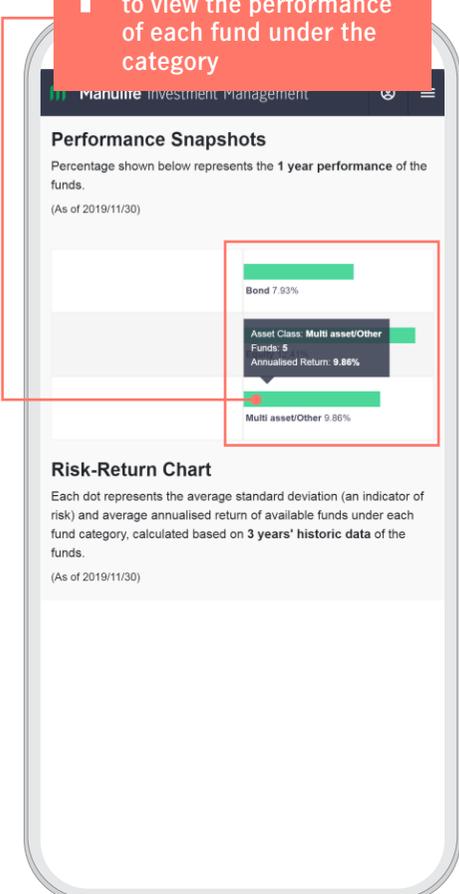
**9** Scroll down to view the basic information of the fund. Click on the fund name to get more details, such as related fund documents



# Performance Snapshots

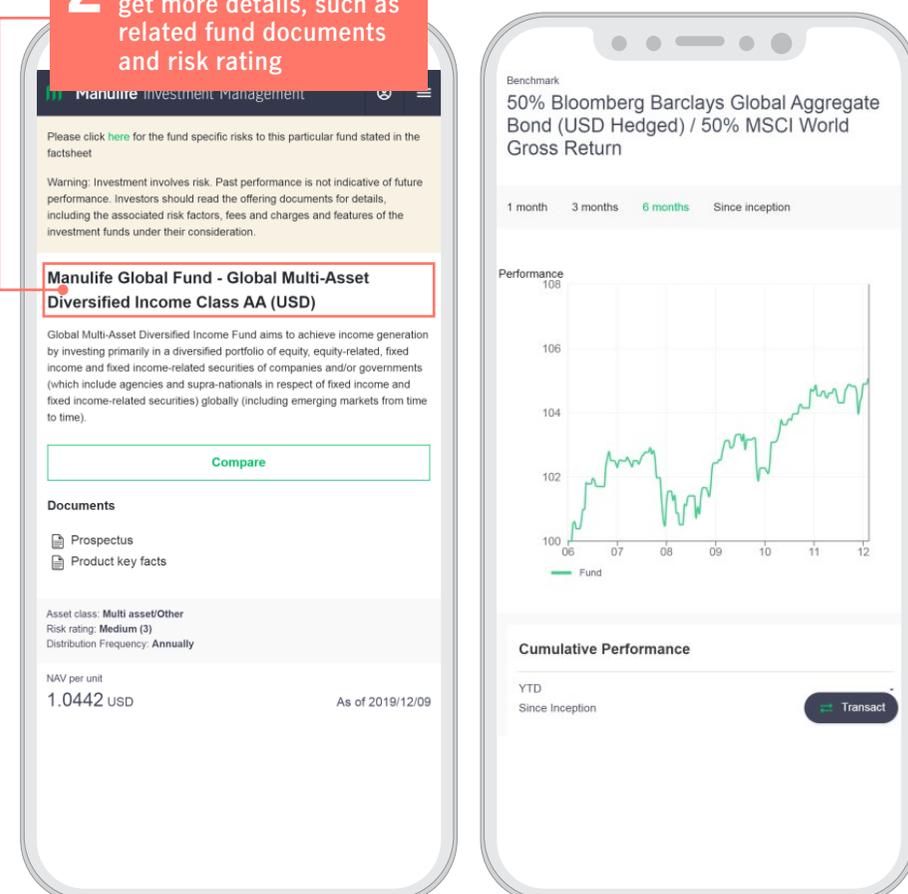
The two charts in this section show you the funds' performance and risk-return profiles across different asset classes. The first chart shows you the 1-year performance of the funds under each fund category.
